

# CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION CALL FOR PAPERS HANNOVER MESSE 2022

## Conditions of Participation Call for Papers for HANNOVER MESSE 2022 (30 May – 2 June) - From 15 February 2022 -

1.	The following conditions of participation apply to exhibitors at HANNOVER MESSE 2022 participating in Call for Papers.
2.	Only exhibitors/co-exhibitors (physical or digital) who are already registered for HANNOVER MESSE 2022 can apply via Call for Papers for the Onsite Expert Stages listed below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ <b>Industry 4.0</b> Expert Stage (onsite incl. livestreaming) - Hall 8</li><li>▪ <b>Energy 4.0</b> Expert Stage (onsite incl. livestreaming) - Hall 12</li><li>▪ <b>Tech transfer</b> Expert Stage (onsite incl. livestreaming) - Hall 17</li></ul>
3.	The application is first made via the online contact form (online from 15 February 2022). The applicant then needs to enter the content for the lecture via the online speaker portal "Daily Fair REF".  The login data for "Daily Fair REF" will be sent to the speaker or the deviating contact person for the thematically matching Expert Stage within 48 hours (on working days) by e-mail (sender: hannovermesse.dailyfair@messe.de) from 15 February 2022.  The deadline for submissions will be <b>23 March 2022!</b>
4.	In order for the submitted paper to be evaluated by the program jury, the following information, which has to be recorded via "Daily Fair REF", is required: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ First name/last name, function, company) speaker</li><li>▪ Presentation title German + English (max. 100 characters each incl. spaces)</li><li>▪ Short abstract (max. 900 characters incl. spaces German or/and English)</li></ul> <p>Promotional presentations as well as pre-recorded presentations cannot be considered for the Onsite Expert Stages.</p> <p>For product and company presentations, we recommend booking a livestreaming slot on the Virtual Expert Stages Industrie 4.0, Energy 4.0 or Tech Transfer (available from early February 2022 in the HANNOVER MESSE Shop).</p>
5.	The evaluation of the submitted presentations will be made by a program jury of the respective Onsite Expert Stages after the deadline.  Selection criteria for the submitted presentations are primarily the content, but also the presence of the speaker as well as exhibitors who are exhibiting physically.  Duration of the presentation: approx. 15-20 min. incl. Q&A.  Applicants will subsequently be notified by email <b>as from mid-April</b> whether the submitted presentation has been accepted by the program jury.
6.	A reorientation of the presentation is not possible after the confirmation by Deutsche Messe. However, presentation content can still be edited/updated.
7.	Participation is free of charge. Additional Partner Packages (limited) for the Onsite Expert Stages can be booked via the HANNOVER MESSE Shop (from early February 2022).
